Diving in to Summer Ministry

This summer the Arise workers are helping out with all aspects of *CEF*'s summer ministry. They were able to help out during *CEF* of Oregon's *Christian Youth In Action* program this June. During *CYIA* they were able to minister to teens as counselors, team leaders and as ARISE missionaries. They were able to encourage the teens with their personal testimonies and share about the ARISE program. Many teens were interested in the program during the week.

In their local areas they're helping coordinate and teach 5 Day Clubs. On the Westside of Portland,

Michele has been able to help teach teens in Westside's CYIA program as well as teach 5 Day Clubs. They are also seeking the Lord for a strategic plan to minister to the Hispanic community. Meanwhile on the Eastside of Portland, Daniel and Rachael have been coordinating and transporting teens for 5 Day Clubs this summer, as well as teaching in 5 Day Clubs. 

About the ARISE Program

If you ask any missionary what the two greatest needs are in their missions field you'll probably hear them say, lack of funding and lack of workers. Jesus said to His disciples in Matthew 9:37, "The harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few.", our response to that verse is found in the verse that follows, Matthew 9:38, "...Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." We have been praying to the Lord of the harvest and He has sent new young workers. However before these workers can go out to work full time with CEF they need to raise their funds and be trained. This process is necessary but it can leave some disheartened and cause them to leave. This is why the ARISE program was created. The ARISE program helps young people who are called to the missions field get the training they need while raising their support. The program begins with an internship at the CEF office in Portland or at the State office, where they will get experience assisting workers in a local office. Then they will get trained at *CEF*'s training institute, *CMI*, for 3 months before coming back to work in Portland as an apprentice missionary. As an apprentice they will learn hands on how to run the various parts of a local office, from being a ministry coordinator to being a local director. During this process they would be raising their personal support, so by the end of the apprenticeship they would be a fully funded CEF missionary. The goal of the ARISE program is to get new fully funded *CEF* workers in Oregon who will reach children and equip others to reach children. We hope that by the end of the program each new worker will have equipped others to reach children, so that the impact of the ARISE missionaries will impact the lives of thousands of children.



This year *CEF* of Oregon would like to see 2 people join the ARISE Internship Program. We need to raise \$10,000 by December for the 2 new Arise workers. This money would provide them with tuition for the *Children's Ministries Institute*. The 3 month training course to equip CEF workers at *CEF* International Headquarters. Please prayerfully consider partnering with us financially to reach this goal.
